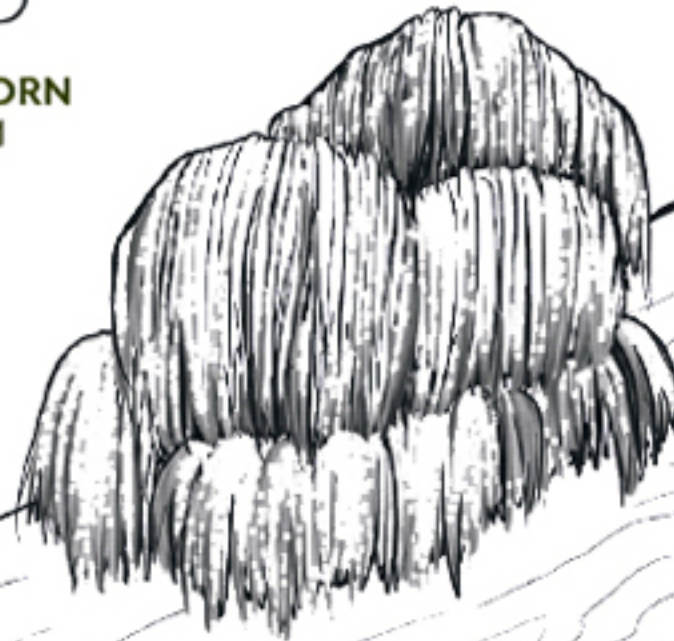

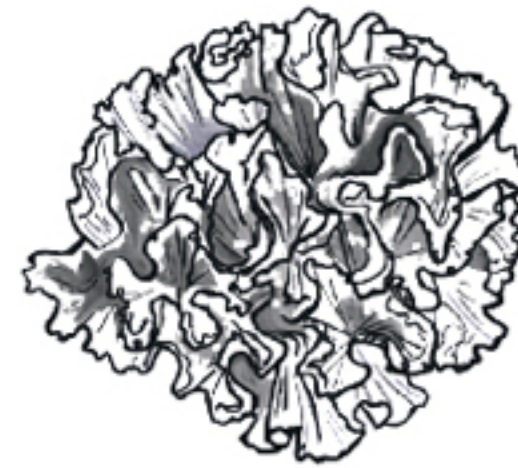

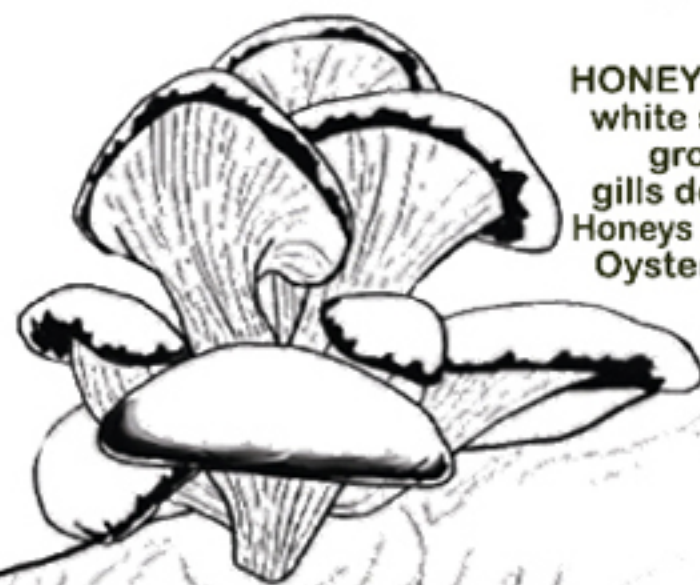
MATSUTAKE, KNIGHTS, CATS, CHICKEN & WOODWAXES
firm fleshed, some with ring, attached gills, white spores
p.234-253



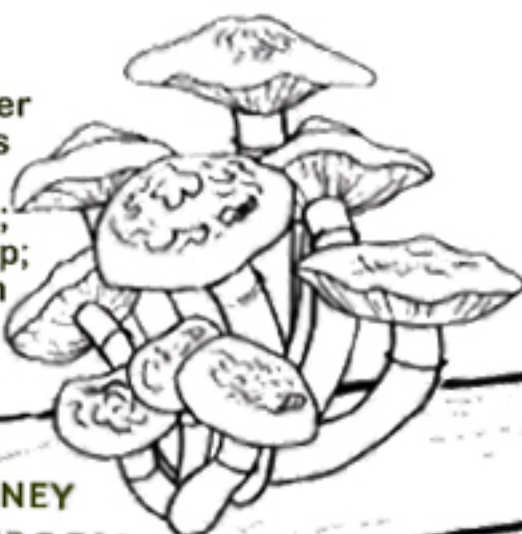
MILKCAPS & BRITTLELEGS
stems break like chalk, no ring, smooth cap, white, cream to yellow spores, Milkcaps oozing milk,
p.192-205



FLY AGARIC & AMANITAS
smooth cap with warts or patch, widened stem base with cup or rings, free gills, white spores
p. 206-224



HONEYS, OYSTERS & other white spored mushrooms
growing on wood, gills decurrent to adnate; Honeys ringed with scaly cap; Oysters with lateral stem

CONIFER TUFT



FUNNELCAPS & PINWHEELS
no ring, spores white and pinkish
Funnelcaps gills adnate to decurrent, Pinwheels gills adnate to free with slender stems, p. 253-264

PARASOLS, DAPPERLINGS & OTHERS
most white spored, with ring & often slender,
p. 224-234

SLIME SPIKE

SLIME & PINE SPIKES, GILLED BOLETE
smokey gray to black spores (or yellow brown for Gilled bolete), decurrent gills, on ground, p. 320-325

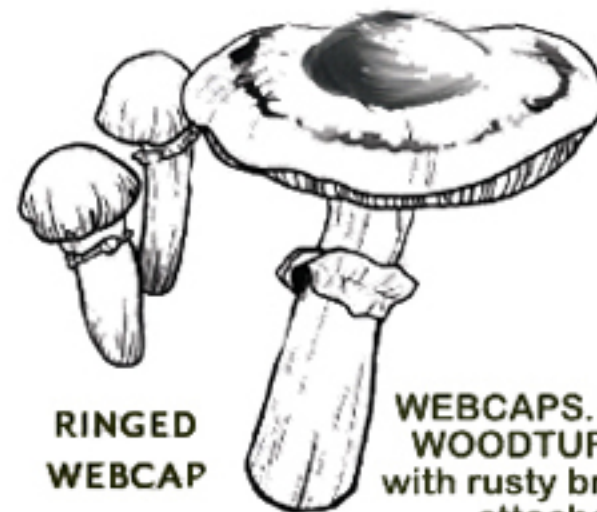
GILLED MUSHROOMS WITH DARK SPORES

MEADOW & HORSE MUSHROOMS & PRINCE, pink (whitish) free gills turning chocolate brown from spores, with ring

DEER & SWEET BREAD MUSHROOMS & ROSEGILLS - pink spored, no ring, on ground or wood

RINGED WEBCAP

WEBCAPS. SHEATHED WOODTUFT & others
with rusty brown spores, attached gills, with ring or web
p. 289 -298

CONIFER TUFT, FIELD CAP, WINE & WAVY CAPS & ROUNDHEAD
cold dark brown, purple brown & purple black spores, ringed, many on wood
p. 310-320

SHAGGY MANE & INK CAPS
black spored, no ring, elongated, often liquifying caps, on ground or wood
